Definition of *special*

(Entry 1 of 2)

1: distinguished by some unusual quality *especially* : being in some way superior *our special blend*

2: held in particular esteem *a special friend*

3a: readily distinguishable from others of the same category : UNIQUE *they set it apart as a special day of thanksgiving*

b: of, relating to, or constituting a species : SPECIFIC

4: being other than the usual : ADDITIONAL, EXTRA

5: designed for a particular purpose or occasion

Definition of *special* (Entry 2 of 2)

1: one that is used for a special service or occasion *caught the commuter special to work*

2: something (such as a television program) that is not part of a regular series

3: a featured dish at a restaurant *the specials of the day*
